





LukeCamp does not have a traditional brick and mortar building. We hire and train amazing staff and then go and serve in underserved communities without the restrictions of being tied to one location. We meet for breakfast each morning with the campers and then start our day with adventure based - hands on learning themed around a Biblical virtue including fitness and the kids have tons of fun. This creates opportunities to meet new people and experience different parts of the city. So the funds usually associated with a facility, are invested in the campers with activities that include - biking, job exploration, museum tours, community service, hiking, basic life skill classes, visiting parks, budget planning and more.
